

# RESIST Week 6: Stay & Go

Scripture: Luke 23:49; 23:55–24:12

Big Idea: Faithfulness means staying when it's hard and going when it doesn't make sense.

Theme: Ordinary faithfulness leads to extraordinary moments with God.

## GROUP OPENER

Icebreaker: What's something you've started but didn't finish?

Why is it hard to stay committed when things get difficult?

## SCRIPTURE MOMENT

Read Luke 23:49 and Luke 24:1–8. Reflect on who stayed, who left, and who went.

## TEACHING RECAP

- 1 Sometimes we are called to STAY when everyone else leaves
- 2 Sometimes we are called to GO when everyone else stays
- 3 Faithfulness positions us to experience resurrection

## DISCUSSION 1: Where We Check Out

Where do you tend to check out when life gets hard?

Do you relate more to: sell out, hide out, check out, or stick it out?

## DISCUSSION 2: The Power of Staying

Why did the women stay when others didn't?

When have you stayed when it would've been easier to leave?

Who has stayed for you?

## DISCUSSION 3: The Courage to Go

Why did the women go without a plan?

Where might God be calling you to go right now?

What holds you back?

## **APPLICATION**

Where do you need to STAY?

Where do you need to GO?

## **PRAYER**

Pray for strength to stay, courage to go, and hope to trust God.

## **BOTTOM LINE**

Faithfulness often looks ordinary. But God uses ordinary faithfulness to change the world.
