Job Title: Creative Experience Director

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Creative Experience Manager oversees the planning, set up and production of the live worship environment and special events. This person is responsible for developing visual components of worship that implement the vision and philosophy of the church's leadership in services and events. The Creative Experience Manager oversees all the visual elements of the stage and adjacent areas including set design, lobby décor and managing volunteer team members.

- Communicate the vision given by New Life Covenant leadership to team members as directed.
- Assist senior leadership in bringing forth innovative, original, creative decor for all visual elements for all church wide and or ministry events.
- Design sketches and develop proposals for various stage sets, events and art projects.
- Construct prototypes of approved stage sets for all services and events as needed.
- Ensure proper stage setup for all services, rehearsals and events.
- Provide leadership to volunteers on stage, design, and event management team.
- Recruit and train the team of volunteers for weekly services.
- Communicate with potential volunteers and utilize them effectively based on their expertise.
- Organize volunteer schedules to construct projects in a timely manner.

- Develop and adhere to the department budget when recommending and engaging vendors and ordering supplies for projects.
- Organize materials and files as well as maintain an inventory of supplies.
- Create an atmosphere that enhances the experience of the visitors, guests and attendees.
- Assist other departments/ministries with event planning needs throughout the church.
- Oversee servant meal distribution for Sunday operations and church wide events
- Attend weekly planning meetings, debrief meetings, and any other meetings as necessary.
- Collaborate with pertinent department leaders of any technical needs.
- Maintain backstage, stage areas, dock areas, storage areas to ensure they are clean and organize
- Other duties may be assigned.
