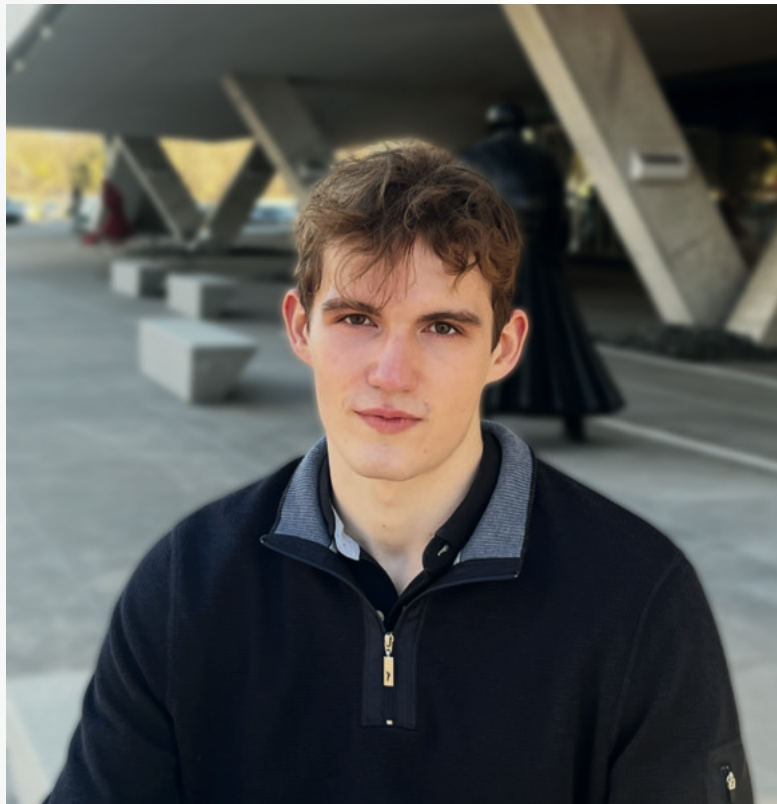
Henry Heininger
