AUDITION DAY: WHAT TO EXPECT

Audition day will be structured primarily around **ensemble work**, followed by smaller-group and scene work as the afternoon progresses.

If you are auditioning for ensemble:

You may be released after the ensemble portion of the audition. You will be contacted afterward regarding casting and next steps.

If you are auditioning for a specific role:

You may be asked to stay for additional scene work, singing, or callbacks.

Please come prepared to participate, take direction, and have fun!

WHAT TO WEAR

Please come dressed for movement.

Wear:

- Comfortable clothing that allows you to move freely
- Comfortable, closed-toe shoes that are easy to move in

What not to wear:

- Inappropriate or distracting graphics
- Clothing that restricts movement
- Open-toed shoes
- Anything that could create a safety issue during movement

WHAT TO BRING

- Water bottle
- Snacks

Auditions may take several hours, so please plan accordingly.

This will be our first full-cast table read as we begin bringing *David: A Musical* to life.

TENTATIVE REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

** Please note that the rehearsal schedule is **tentative and subject to change** as we continue finalizing the script, music, choreography, and production needs.*

MANDATORY DATES

Tech Week and Performance Days are mandatory.

If you already know that you have a conflict with any of the mandatory dates, **please let leadership know as soon as possible.**

We want to build a schedule that allows our cast and creative team to succeed together.

REHEARSAL ATTENDANCE

Consistency matters.

Because this is a collaborative production, every cast member's presence affects the entire team. Missing more than three rehearsals **may result in recasting or removal from the production**, depending on the circumstances and production needs.

If you have known conflicts with the rehearsal schedule, please communicate them **before accepting a role** whenever possible.

Our goal isn't simply to have people show up—we want to build a team that can depend on one another.
