

THE KICKOFF

Services and a fun parking lot party helped us kickoff a new season of life. We enjoyed food trucks & fellowship as a church community.

TRUNK OR TREAT

Trunk or Treat returned for its 21st Annual event. We supported local businesses by welcoming 6 food truck vendors this year. 67 Trunk Hosts and 150 volunteers helps us accomplish this outreach events, with over 1,800 people attending.

FALL FEST

Once again, Crossroads served as the Parade Marshal for the Sylvania Fall Parade, riding in the parade with our band float. Volunteers helped at our Main St. booth, as we connected with our neighboring community.

CHRISTMAS

1,423 joined us in-person and online to celebrate the birth of our Savior!

ANGEL TREE

244 children in NW Ohio and SE Michigan received gifts from the 2022 Angel Tree. 27 amazing volunteers helped make this happen by collecting information, making & distributing tags, gift collection, and sorting and playing "Santa" delivering the gifts.

GOD WORKS

Each Thursday, the GodWorks team serves a home cooked meal at Crossroads. Over 1,400 meals were served in 2022. The GodWorks team consists of 30+ volunteers who plan, cook, and serve meals.













**Spring:** Over 180 bags filled with groceries were donated, plus enough FOOD DROPS funds to cover the cost of Easter Hams. 170 local families were served, and 101 volunteers helped us pull off this amazing outreach opportunity.

Fall: Over 100 volunteers sorted and distributed food, as well as provided special hospitality for our quests with window washing, hot beverages, cookies, and prayer while they waited. 382 turkeys, loads of fresh produce, and over 250 bags of pantry items donated by you!

CHIP N FOR CHILL

80 golfers, along with generous donors, helped Crossroads raise over \$8,000 for children's projects in NW Ohio and SE Michigan.

Over 100 bags of coats, clothing, blankets, and more were donated to 1Matters annual event, Tent City, where they spend the weekend supporting local homeless and veterans.

BLOOMS FOR TEACHERS

Crossroads Sylvania supported local business, Beautiful Blooms by Jen with her campaign to provide every teacher in Sylvania a flower bouquet for Valentines.

PRAISE GARDEN

18 volunteers served over 960 hours planting and harvesting. 13 local pantries in SE MI and NW OH were given over 3,500lbs of fresh veggies from the Praise Garden in 2022!

#### **FACILITY UPGRADES:**

- Kids Street: 1st grade classroom build was finished, which provided us space to have a separate dedicated supply room!
- Auditorium: We were able to upgrade our deteriorating screens so that we can display a clear video of our worship services.

- Fall Kickoff: The Big Party This night helped us jump start our Wednesday night gatherings, providing a weekly opportunity for students to hear a message, engaged in groups, and worship together.
- Small Groups: 89 students participated throughout the year



MARKA, JORDAN: Pastor Haytham, Marka Church From December 2021 through January 2022, Crossroads aimed to raise \$175,000 for the annual HOC offering. As it turned out, together we donated a record **\$245,630!** 

Here's how that money was put to use:

#### MISSION SSFAC (LOCAL): \$24.563.09

Helped support Social Services for the Arab Community's Family Education Plan (FEP) and their Advance Program. The FEP helps parents and children learn English and helps navigate communications with schools. The Advance Program helps immigrants and refugees find gainful employment.

#### MISSION EBENEZER GLENN ORPHANAGE (GLOBAL): \$24.563.09

EGO is one of our longtime mission partners. Due to the civil unrest in Haiti, starvation, gangs, and earthquakes have ravaged the nation. Their most critical need has been food, formula, and medicines. Our support helped them receive essential goods to keep their orphan children alive and well.

#### CROSSROADS: \$196.504.66

These funds allowed us to complete a 3 month emergency operating fund, and move along Crossroads Plan for Financial Health. Completing this fund allows us to aggressively address Crossroads Mortgage debt.


