Exit Strategy - Week 6

- God's **distinctness** doesn't **distance** you; it invites you to **belong**.
- Exodus 40:9-10 (NLT) "Take the anointing oil and anoint the Tabernacle and all its furnishings to consecrate them and make them **holy**. Anoint the altar of burnt offering and its utensils to consecrate them. Then the altar will become absolutely **holy**."
- Holy 83
- Holy: Exalted or worthy of complete devotion as one perfect in goodness and righteousness
- Holiness **Revealed**
 - Exodus 3:5, 15:11 – (smaller Font)
- Holiness
 - God = utterly distinct in who He is
- Holiness begins with who God is, not what we do.
- Holiness **Required**
 - Exodus 19-20 – (smaller Font)
- Holiness
 - God = utterly distinct in who He is.
 - Us = set apart for God
- If you belong to a holy God, your life will look different.
- Holiness **Structured**
 - Exodus 25-31– (smaller Font)

- Holiness doesn't mean "trying harder to be good."
- Holiness is belonging so completely to God that your life becomes different
- Exodus 40:34-38 (NLT) Then the cloud covered the Tabernacle, and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle.

- Holiness Dwelling
- Exodus 40 – (smaller Font)
