### I Doubt It Week 1

- Sarah and Abraham (*Genesis 17:17, 18:12*)

- Matthew 28
- Matthew 28:16 -17 (NLT) Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him—but some of them doubted!
- Matthew 28:19 - 20 (NLT) Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”

- No Bend
- John 20:24-25 (NLT) One of the twelve disciples, Thomas (nicknamed the Twin), was not with the others when Jesus came. They told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he replied, "I won't believe it unless I see the nail wounds in his hands, put my fingers into them, and place my hand into the wound in his side."
- Your doubts don't make you bad, they make you human.
- John 14
- John 14:5 (NLT) "No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?"
- John 11:16 (NLT) Thomas, nicknamed the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let's go, too - and die with Jesus."

- John 20:26-28 (NLT) **Eight days later** the disciples were together again, and this time Thomas was with them. The doors were locked;
- John 20:26-28 (NLT) but suddenly, as before, Jesus was standing among them. "Peace be with you," he said. Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and look at my hands. Put your hand into the wound in my side. Don't be faithless any longer. Believe!"
- Faith is Not a destination it's a journey.
