- 2 Timothy 2:24-25 (NLT) A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be **kind** to everyone, be able to teach, and be **patient** with difficult people. \
- 2 Timothy 2:24-25 (NLT) Gently instruct those who oppose the **truth**. Perhaps God will change those people's hearts, and they will learn the **truth**.
