Packing List

- A Bible and Pen
- Sleeping Bag or Bedding for a Twin Bed
(Don't forget your pillow!)
- Towels
(Suggestion: Write your name on your towels.)
- Toiletries
(Toothpaste, Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant, etc)
- Swimsuit (must be appropriate)
Boys: Shorts/Swimsuit must be fingertip length
Girls: Modest One Piece/or shirt over two-piece
(Bring a cover-up outfit for walking to the lake.)
- Flashlight
- Dress Code Appropriate Clothing
(Shorts **MUST** be at or below finger-tip length. Tanks are allowed, but no spaghetti straps or mid-drifts. If the outfit violates these simple rules, please don't pack it.)
- Jackets/Rain Clothing
- Theme Night Clothes
(See the schedule for all Theme Nights)
- Extra Shoes
(Have extras in case one gets wet. Flip flops can be worn to the shower, but not around camp.)
- Bag for your Dirty Clothes
- Note about Snacks
Snacks in your cabin must be stored in a well-sealed container. Anything open invites mice or other creatures to your bunk.

Check-In Info/Stations

- Lice Check
- Forms and Fees
Camp staff will have a final check to make sure registration is completed, fees are paid, and your health form is submitted.
- Cabin assignments
You are not allowed to go to your cabin before registering.
- Team assignments
- Canteen will be provided once a day
- Medicine Check-In
ALL meds must be checked in to the camp nurses. They will make sure the camper has what they need at the specified times.

What NOT To Bring:

- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, fireworks, matches, lighters, knives, or firearms are allowed in camp.
(I know some of this seems obvious, but parents, please make sure your campers do not pack any of these items. Possession of these items could mean immediate dismissal from camp.)
- No cabin raids or pranks.
- No writing on walls or beds.
- No leaving designated areas.
- No bad attitudes toward each other or toward the staff.
