General data

Hello, brothers thank God we are very well, the weather in the country has been very changeable, we have days with a lot of sun and others with a lot of rain, it is not frequent at this time to have sun, but things are not very stable in terms of the weather. Our area is going through some strikes and protests due to the issue of illegal mining in our country in the northern zone, but thank God it has not affected us.

Work:

- 1) We continued with the Wednesday Bible studies, we had 4 studies this month.
- 2) This month I had the opportunity to teach 2 youth workshops, one in the Church building and one in the hall of another community.
- 3) During this month I have been working with a married couple, we had 3 marriage counseling classes.
- 4) For this month we had 2 sermons in the day and 2 sermons in the evening.
- 5) We did not teach the book of facts, because now Brother Diego will be in charge of giving them.

Special situations

1. Brother Diego and I had some problems with the Bible podcast project, as we used appropriate lapel microphones, we are still working on this, we want to produce good material.
2. We have 3 new students at World Bible School, my wife also adopted 1 more student, we hope this is good for God's kingdom.
3. During this month I have had to work with a complicated marriage case, on two occasions I had to return home at 1 in the morning, I began to work with them on a regular basis, unfortunately they are separated for the moment, I ask for your prayers that the word of God will help this couple to continue their marriage.
4. This month we had the couples meeting where we participated with 5 more couples from the church.
5. Because of my studies at university, I have had the opportunity to get closer to other communities with educational workshop work, as my career is about religious education, I can talk to them about God, I have had good experiences in this.
6. We are working with Don Silvio, this is a 60-year-old man who has been visiting us for several months, he is Cuban, we hope that he will soon obey and be baptized.
7. During this month we have had some new visitors, a man close to the community, a young man from a somewhat distant district, also 1 lady with her 3 children and her aunt, the work of evangelism through social networks is helping us.
8. We are preparing for the campaign with Henderso for this beginning of July, we are very motivated.
