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EVANGELISTIC AND MINISTRY REPORT

May and June 2026

Dear elders, leadership, and brethren in Christ,

Receive warm greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is a privilege to present this report covering the work carried out during the months of **May and June 2026** in the ministry of the Church of Christ in Ciudad Quesada, Costa Rica.

Throughout this period, work continued in several areas of ministry, including preaching, Bible teaching, personal evangelism, biblical counseling, and the spiritual strengthening of the congregation. Every effort has been made with the purpose of honoring God and remaining faithful to the biblical pattern established in the New Testament (1 Peter 4:11; 2 Timothy 2:15).

I. EVANGELISTIC WORK AND VISITATION

Throughout the months of May and June, evangelistic efforts continued within the community through personal visits, individual conversations, and follow-up with contacts interested in studying the Bible.

Efforts were made to strengthen relationships with different individuals in the community in order to open new opportunities to share the gospel and teach God's truth clearly and according to sound doctrine.

Special emphasis continued to be placed on:

- Biblical authority
- The call to repentance
- Obedience to the gospel
- The restoration of New Testament Christianity

The primary objective has been to maintain a consistent evangelistic effort focused on the salvation of souls and the spiritual edification of those who express an interest in studying the Scriptures (Matthew 28:19–20).

II. PREACHING AND TEACHING MINISTRY

During May and June, several activities related to the public teaching of God's Word were carried out, including:

- Preaching sermons during the congregational worship services.
- Teaching Bible classes, including a study of Acts chapter 9.
- Assisting in various teaching and edification activities.
- Continuing my work as a teacher with the World Bible School (WBS).

In addition, progress was made in the expository study of the book of Acts, with special emphasis on the chapters describing Paul's missionary journeys and the growth of the early church.

The purpose of these lessons has been to strengthen the congregation's biblical knowledge and encourage the brethren to grow in faithfulness and Christian service (Ephesians 4:12–13).

III. BIBLE STUDIES AND SPIRITUAL FOLLOW-UP

Throughout these two months, personal Bible studies continued with individuals who desired to learn more about the gospel.

These studies have focused on:

- The plan of salvation
- The identity of the New Testament church
- The development of biblical faith
- The necessity of obeying God's will

In addition to the formal Bible studies, regular communication and spiritual follow-up were maintained with several contacts in order to encourage their spiritual growth and deepen their understanding of the Scriptures.

IV. BIBLICAL COUNSELING AND SPIRITUAL SUPPORT

Biblical counseling and spiritual encouragement continued to be provided to a number of individuals through personal counseling sessions and spiritual support for families.

Regular contact was also maintained through virtual meetings to provide biblical guidance in areas such as:

- Family problems
- Emotional encouragement
- Spiritual growth
- Biblical guidance for personal situations

In every case, God's Word has remained the primary foundation for providing counsel, encouragement, and direction (Romans 15:4).

V. CONGREGATIONAL EDIFICATION AND DEVELOPMENT

During this period, I actively participated in several congregational activities designed to strengthen the local church.

These efforts included:

- Participating in fellowship activities.
- Assisting in Bible classes for different groups.
- Developing new initiatives for spiritual training.
- Preaching and teaching classes at the congregation in Alajuela.
- Preparing written teaching materials on various biblical subjects. I am currently planning to have these materials printed for the benefit of the congregation in Costa Rica and, Lord willing, for use in other Latin American countries as well.

Planning also continued for:

- A Bible study group specifically for senior adults.
- Biblical leadership training for men interested in teaching and leadership.
- Doctrinal and practical training materials.

The continuing goal is to strengthen the local congregation in unity, sound doctrine, and faithful Christian service (Ephesians 4:15–16).

VI. MINISTRY PROJECTS AND FUTURE PLANS

During this period, progress continued on several ministry-related projects, including:

- Developing Bible teaching and biblical counseling materials.
- Organizing doctrinal resources for future classes.
- Planning digital evangelistic content.
- Preparing educational projects for ministry training.
- Developing an evangelistic podcast.

Consideration has also continued to be given to expanding the reach of the gospel through digital resources and online Bible teaching.

VII. CHALLENGES AND CURRENT NEEDS

The work continues to present challenges that require perseverance, wisdom, and constant prayer.

Some of the present challenges include:

- Maintaining consistent follow-up with evangelistic contacts.
- Increasing opportunities for personal Bible studies.
- Continuing to strengthen new congregational projects.
- Effectively balancing the various responsibilities of the ministry.

Despite these challenges, we thank God for allowing us to continue working and serving in His kingdom.

VIII. GOALS FOR THE COMING MONTHS

With the Lord's help, the immediate goals include:

- Increasing the number of personal Bible studies.
- Strengthening the biblical counseling ministry.
- Training more brethren in teaching and leadership.
- Expanding evangelistic efforts both within and beyond the local community.
- Continuing several Bible studies in nearby communities as well as in more distant areas.
