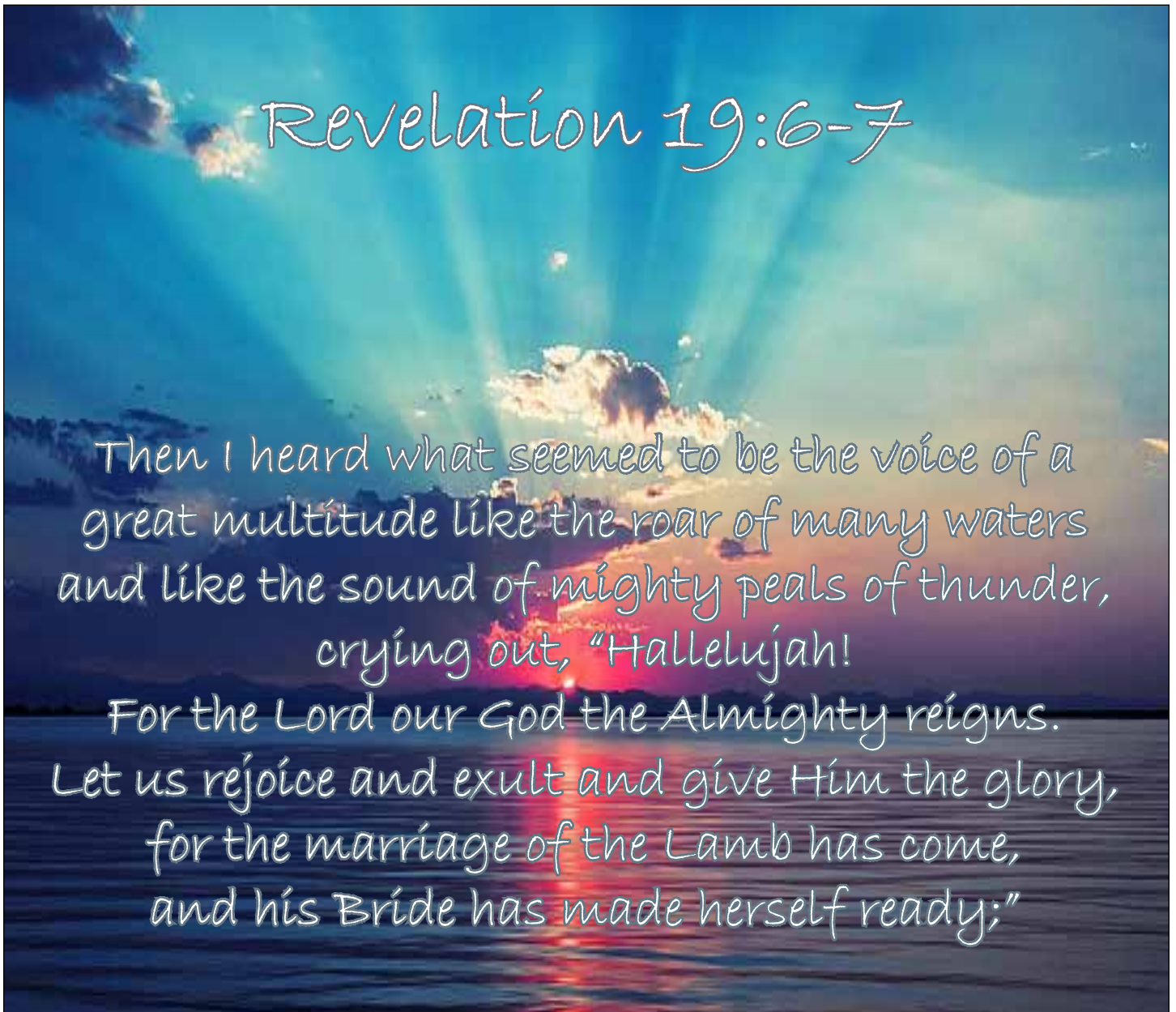
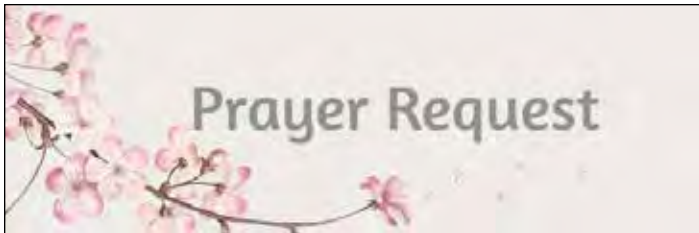

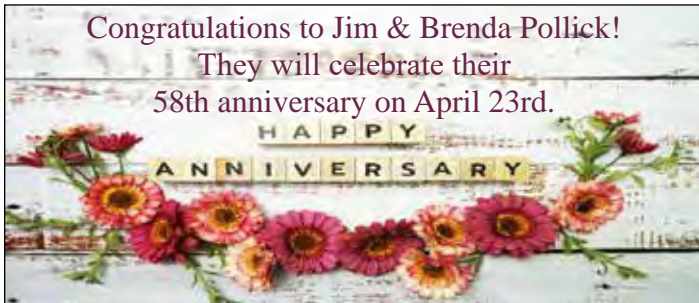

Jesus and His White Horse

Knowing the outcome of a battle (any struggle in life) changes how we engage in the battle. It removes all anxiety and fears of what might happen.

In the era of Rome, a general would ride back from battle on a white horse to symbolize the victory that his forces had. It was a symbol of dominant rule and royalty. John was shown a message of hope and joy that overcomes all anxiety and fear.

John recorded seeing Jesus ride a white horse into battle (Rev. 19:11), demonstrating that he has already won the war. What might be considered an arrogant gesture in Roman culture is, for Jesus, a symbol that the battle has already been won! The battle is over before it even begins. He will not come to earth to struggle against the enemy (sin, corruption, brokenness, fear, anxiety...). He will come to destroy the enemy and free the captives. The spoils of war already belongs to Jesus. We who follow Him are given white horses and white robes because we are the captives who are freed, the spoils of war that God so cherishes that He paid the price to win. Jesus is superior, and the victory is already won!
