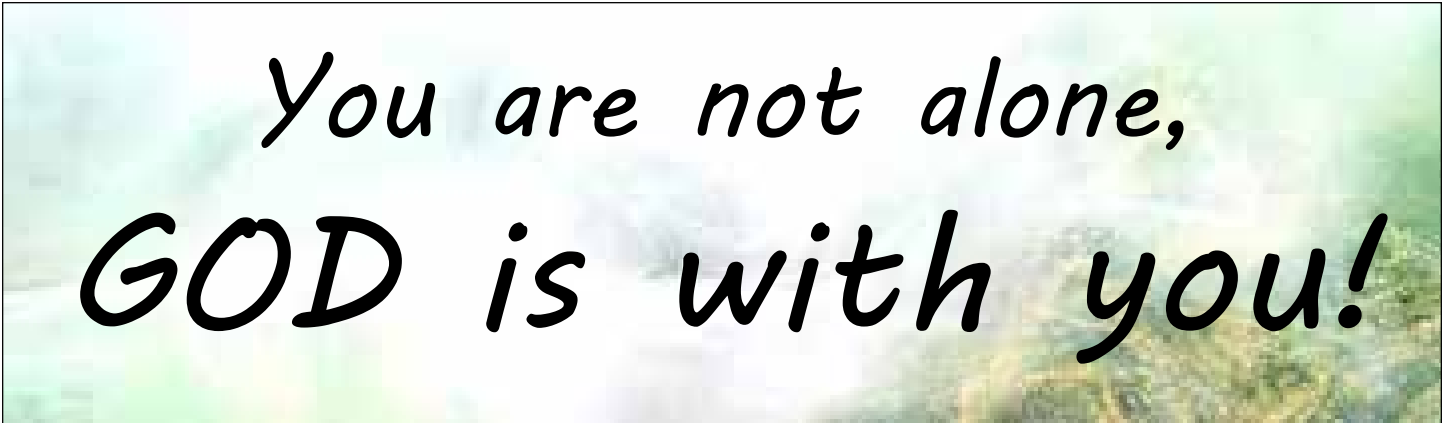
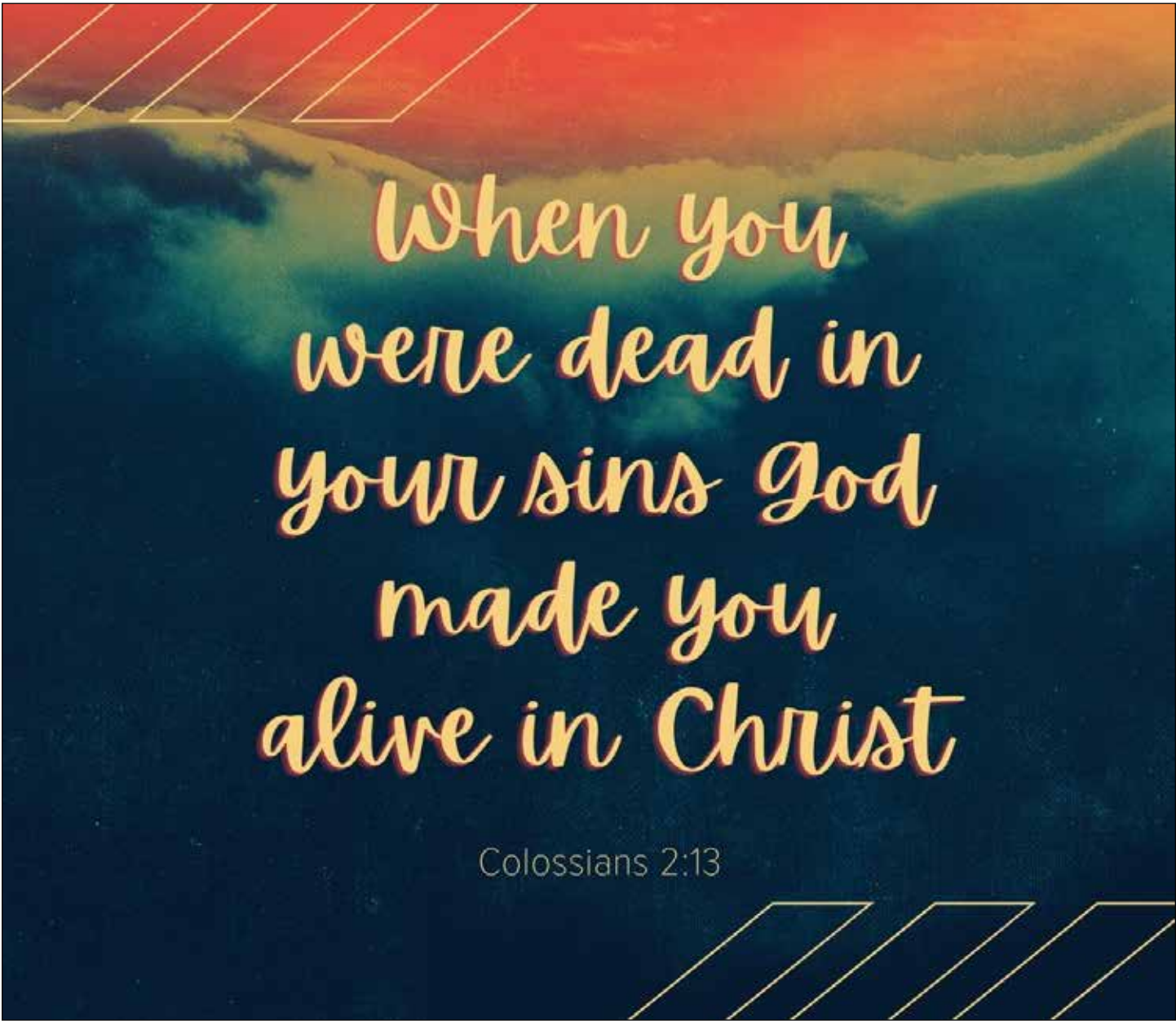

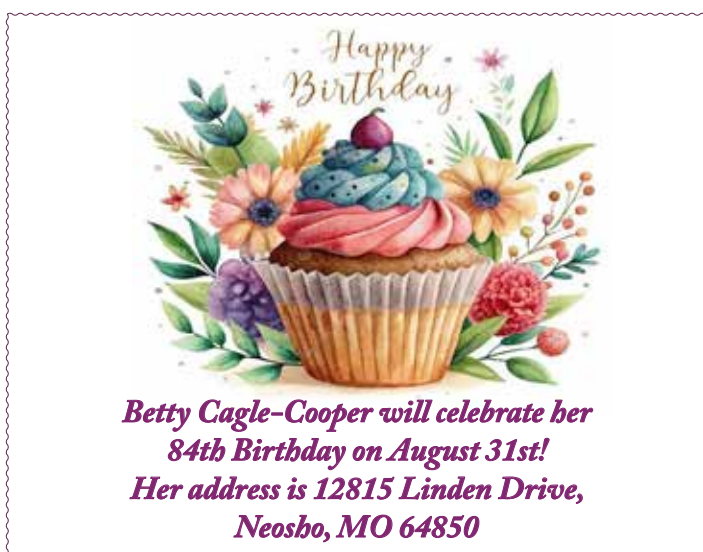
Thank you! To all the men who spoke on Wednesday nights this summer, thank you. To all who heard their stories and were encouraged in their walk with Jesus, thank you.
