




Your Mistakes Do Not Make You Alone

Many years ago, I was blessed to be at a Bible Camp session with a group of great young men who were being very real and honest about life. This was a High School aged camp session with many college aged counselors. These men (because that's how these teenagers were acting and being), were exploring the question of how to be after camp was over.

During the week, many of them, if not all, had confessed and repented of many sins that they had struggled with in their lives before camp. They expressed that camp was a wonderful place to accept God's gift of grace and live without a lot of temptations. Camp makes being good easy.

But they had a problem. They knew that camp would soon be over. That worried them. "What happens when I go back to normal life and mess up again? I'll feel like I'm alone and a failure in following Jesus?" These two questions summed up their collective struggle.

So, I told them, "You keep following Jesus. You keep living into the truth of forgiveness that cleanses you from sins and removes your guilt, guilt that increases the potential for further mistakes. This is what all followers of Jesus do as they follow Jesus. You are not alone in your fear of not being good enough, but Jesus makes you good enough."

Over the years, I have been able to reconnect with many of these young men and hear their stories of victory over temptations. Many of them have shared with me that it was these conversations, that we had together, that helped them realize that they really could receive God's gift of Grace and not give in to temptations. And when they made mistakes, they kept following Jesus and did better the next time.
