Questions for Discussion:

1. Do you struggle with being afraid to be a witness for Jesus?
2. Consider ways you can encourage one another to trust God and be at peace.
3. Do you see yourself on mission with King Jesus?
4. Do you see worshipping God as your primary mission in life?
5. What are some things you are tempted to worship besides God? Repent and ask God to be first in your life, over all idols.
6. Do you believe that without the Holy Spirit, no one can see Jesus and truly worship him?
7. Ask for the Holy Spirit to fill you and empower you to worship God and to be his witness.
8. Consider the Trinitarian work of God in our redemption. Read all of John 17 and consider more the ways the Triune God calls us into fellowship within himself.
9. Do you see your profession as the thing you do to make money or is your primary profession to be on mission for Jesus Christ? Be honest and ask God to help you find your identity in Christ alone.
10. Are you a fisher of men? Ask God to make you a better fisher of men, trusting that God is the one who will catch the fish, our responsibility is to proclaim the gospel?
