Emmanuel Family & Friends...I am grateful for another year of ministry as your servant leader. We have made tremendous strides, enhancements, and history in such a short time. I am proud of your followship and sacrifice as we have worked together to steer this ship called Emmanuel into unchartered waters and territory.

As I observe my 15th year of pastoral ministry and 29th year of gospel ministry, I would like to recap the road that has brought me here. This journey began the 4th Sunday in August of 1994 the summer before my senior year in high school. I was licensed under the late Dr. OC Jones at the Mount Pleasant Baptist Church in Little Rock. Dr. Jones was the dean of preachers and taught me a great deal of ministry and pulpit etiquette.

As I transitioned to college, I went to preach at a small rural church (Shady Grove BC) in the community of Beirne in southwest Arkansas, where a huge International Paper lumber yard was found. After preaching for the 3rd or 4th time, a Deacon stood up and said I believe we have found our Pastor. I began to clap with the congregation because I was somewhat relieved that I didn't have to come back down here to preach but be more involved on the college campus. To my amazement, they made a motion and voted me in as Pastor before I could utter yes or no. Later on in ministry, I realized that God sent me there to be cut, processed, and preserved like those huge logs. I was very thankful for the members of Shady Grove their love and support were genuine.

A few years later the members of Warren Hill Baptist Church in North Little Rock, elected me as Pastor. I was apprehensive because this church had 4 pastors in 5 years. This pastorate was where I began to grow as a Pastor and understand the importance of Pastoral Care and Preaching. The church was known as a "singing church" with a very awesome music ministry! It was here, that I learned the value of Worship and the Word. We didn't have a lot of resources at Warren Hill, but we have spirit and unity. Many relationships were forged here that are still active today. God taught me to trust his voice and leading over the events and actions of people. The Lord then moved me/us to Texarkana. Newly married and following the leading of God after Lady Veronica had a medical rotation at the local hospital. I knew that this was where God was sending us. I was candidating at church there but did not win the vote. I was devastated because I knew I had heard God clearly. However, a Deacon/Member from another vacant church in Texarkana were in attendance to hear me and inquired if I would preach at their church. A couple of months later the Macedonia Baptist Church elected me as Pastor. I was proud of the community work, fellowships, and friends that we had established during the 5 years in Texarkana. I learned at Macedonia how to be administratively sound as a Pastor and to transition a traditional church into more of a contemporary, balanced ministry. I am endeared to the many mothers and elderly members who stole my heart. I gained some valuable experience with working with leaders. I also felt a greater pull to return back to school to become more astute in my biblical knowledge and skills.

The road to Beloit has been a bumpy, yet necessary path to follow the will of God for our life. I credit my wife (Lady Veronica), my sons (OJ, Jr, & Landyn) my parents, previous pastors, and my brothers for their continued support, love, and prayers. I am excited for what the future holds for year 3 at Emmanuel.
