DAY 2: START WITH GOD'S WORD

Joshua 1:8 NlrV

The Bible is one of the main ways God speaks to you. When you read it, you aren't just reading words. You are learning who God is. You discover what He loves, how He treats people, and how He wants you to live. Sometimes, reading the Bible can feel confusing or hard. That's okay! Everyone starts somewhere. The important thing is that you begin. Even a few verses can help you understand something new about God.

As you read, ask yourself: "What does this show me about God?" The more you read, the more you will know

God. And the more you know God, the more you will see how He wants you to live your life.

Write one thing you want to learn about God:

DAY 3: THE BIBLE SHOWS YOU TRUTH

Psalm 119:105 NlrV

Tonight, after it gets dark, ask a grown-up to come with you and grab a flashlight. Go outside, and shine the light on the ground as you walk. Notice something: If you look too far away from the light, it's hard to see where you're going. But when you stay close to the light, you can see each step clearly: where to step and where not to step.

When you go back inside, talk with your grown-up about what that was like. How is a flashlight like God's Word? Share ways God has helped guide you, and listen to how your grown-up has seen God guide them too. Then, ask your grown-up to help you practice hearing from God. Maybe you can check in once a week and talk about what you're learning or add "read your Bible" to your daily routine.

Remember, listening to God isn't something you have to do, it's something you get to do! And when you listen to Him, He helps show you the right way to go.

Not sure where to begin? Ask someone at home: "Where do you see God using me right now?" Write their answer:

Hebrews 4:12 NlrV

Ask a trusted grown-up how they read the Bible. Try reading a short passage together this week.

Read Hebrews 4:12

Prayer: “Dear God, help me trust You more than myself. Give me courage to say yes when You lead me. Use my life to do what only You can do. In Jesus’ name. Amen.”
