CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

Drop-Off (Check-In)

- Parents must sign campers in daily
- Campers must be escorted to the designated check-in area
- Staff will verify attendance and safely transition campers to their group

CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

Drop-Off (Check-In)

- Parents must sign campers in daily
- Campers must be escorted to the designated check-in area
- Staff will verify attendance and safely transition campers to their group

Pick-Up (Check-Out)

- Only authorized individuals may pick up campers
- Photo ID may be required
- Campers will only be released through the official check-out process

⚠ For your child's safety, no exceptions will be made.

AUTHORIZED PICK-UP

- Only individuals listed on your Authorized Pick-Up Form may pick up your child
- Any changes must be approved by Camp Leadership
- Custody documentation must be provided if applicable

WHAT TO BRING DAILY

Please send your child with:

- Backpack
- Water bottle
- Lunch & snacks (if applicable)
- Comfortable clothing & closed-toe shoes
- Change of clothes (recommended)
- Sunscreen (applied before arrival)

On Water Days: (Every Wednesday in June, weather permitting)

- Swimsuit
- Towel
- Extra clothes

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Electronics (phones, tablets, gaming devices)
- Valuable items
- Toys from home
- Any prohibited or unsafe items

GraceWay Summer Camp is not responsible for lost or damaged personal belongings.

HEALTH & MEDICAL INFORMATION

- All medical conditions, allergies, and medications must be disclosed
- Medications must be:
 - In original packaging
 - Clearly labeled
 - Given to staff at check-in
- Staff may administer medication only with proper authorization

ILLNESS POLICY

Please keep your child home if they have:

- Fever within the last 24 hours
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Contagious illness

Parents will be contacted if a child becomes ill during camp.

ALLERGY AWARENESS

We take allergies seriously. If your child has a severe allergy:

- Provide all required medication (EpiPen, etc.)
- Complete the Allergy Documentation Form
- Communicate clearly with staff

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

Campers are expected to:

- Show kindness and respect
- Follow instructions
- Participate positively
- Keep hands and feet to themselves

DISCIPLINE APPROACH

We use a positive, structured approach:

1. Redirection
2. Verbal warning
3. Behavior reset
4. Leadership involvement
5. Parent communication (if needed)

Serious or repeated behavior may result in removal from activities or camp.

ANTI-BULLYING POLICY

Bullying is not tolerated.

We promote:

- Inclusion
- Respect
- Kindness

All incidents are taken seriously and addressed immediately.

SAFETY & SUPERVISION

Your child's safety is our highest priority:

- Continuous staff supervision
- Headcounts throughout the day
- Controlled transitions
- Secure facility access

BATHROOM PROCEDURES

- Campers are supervised during restroom breaks
 - Staff remain outside restrooms for safety
 - Younger campers receive appropriate assistance when needed

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event of an emergency (fire, weather, medical, or security):

- Staff follow established emergency protocols
 - Campers are kept safe and accounted for
 - Parents will be notified by Camp Leadership

VISITOR POLICY

- All visitors must check in
 - Must wear identification
 - Are not permitted unsupervised access to campers

PHOTO & SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

- Photos/videos may be taken for camp use with parent consent
 - No camper names will be publicly shared without additional permission
 - Staff and visitors may not post campers on personal social media

COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS

- Important updates will be shared through official camp communication channels
 - Only Camp Leadership will communicate regarding incidents

ATTENDANCE & ABSENCES

- Daily attendance is tracked
- Notify camp if your child will be absent
- Early pickups must go through the check-out process

LATE PICK-UP POLICY

- Campers must be picked up on time
 - Late pickups may result in additional fees or follow-up
