

# ***Ladies Bible Study for April 13<sup>th</sup>***

## **Read & study 2 Thessalonians 2:9-17**

Reread 2 Thes. 2:1-8 to refresh your memory.

**Verses 9-10...**Who is verse 9 referring to? \_\_\_\_\_

Do we currently know who this is? \_\_\_\_\_

Is he alive today? \_\_\_\_\_

- Whose work will he do and how will he do it?
- What kind of person can we assume he will be? Describe him.
- Who will be fooled by his actions?
- Why will they be fooled?

**Verses 11-12...**what does Paul say will happen to unbelievers during this time?

- Why is God going to send a “strong delusion”? Consider these verses: Romans 1:18-32; Isaiah 66:3-4; Jeremiah 14:10
- How do they view wickedness? Do you ever take pleasure in evil? What should a believer do instead?

Ultimately, what is the Truth? And, what can we understand about God’s sovereignty through these verses? Read 2 Peter 3:8-10
