Optional Ice Breaker: What has been a big direction-shifting moments of your life up to this point?

Read Esther 4:12-17

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through Esther together?

What is the context of what is going on among God's people in the book of Esther? (an example: post-exile, in Babylon).

What was the generation opportunity that Esther was presented with? What was her response, and how did it become a generationally impactful decision?

How has the last month gone in relation to meeting with and hearing from God? Have you learned anything about either God or yourself in the process?
