Optional Ice Breaker: Are there any commonly accepted things that you doubt?
(For example: the moon landing).

Read John 20:19-29

Did anything stand out either from Clayton's message or reading through John together?

What is Jesus' greeting each time he sees the disciples after the resurrection? Why do you think that is the greeting He gives?

What is the significance of Jesus' showing physical wounds after His resurrection? As opposed to being fully physically healed in His resurrection?

Why might Thomas have struggled to believe, even after hearing evidence from the others?

Jesus' response to the disciples' fear and doubt is not frustration or annoyance, but an invitation of peace. **What does this say about the character of Jesus? Are there any wrong dispositions of Jesus that you are prone to believe?**

Clayton said that we often can make a God in our minds that more closely resembles ourselves rather than the God of the Bible. **How have you seen that to be true in your own life? How do we sell the goodness and glory of Jesus short by doing so?**

Clayton also mentioned that doubt is not the problem, but rather doubt in isolation. **Why is isolation so dangerous when it comes to doubt? How does being in community (like Life Group) impact how we wrestle with doubt and fear?**

Do you treat yourself like God treats you? (*How does God treat you? With grace, patience, and repeated invitations of His peace in the midst of our sin.*)

When others are in doubt and fear, do you treat them like God treats you?

Have a time of sharing. (i.e. Share highs/lows in this season, needs in your home/community, etc.)
