Optional Ice Breaker: Who is someone (parent, coach, mentor, friend) who gave you advice that really shaped your life. What did they say?

Read Proverbs 3:1-2 and Proverbs 4

What is something that stood out to you from the sermon or Proverbs passage?

How would you summarize the main message of Proverbs 4 in one sentence?

What does it mean to “get wisdom” and “get understanding”? How do we actually do that?

What are the key differences between the “path of the righteous” and the “way of the wicked”? (v 10-19)

Verse 23 says, “Above all else, guard your heart.” **What does that actually mean? What are some practical ways we can guard our hearts in today's culture?**

How do our words (v. 24), eyes (v. 25), and steps (v. 26–27) reflect what's going on in our hearts?

Justin mentioned that when parents screw up, they should repent to their kids. **Did you see that modeled well by your parents? Why can it be difficult for parents to repent to their children?**

The thing that will most rub off on kids is not any lesson their parents teach them, but it is the priorities they modeled to them. **Whether you are a parent or not, if someone were to take an audit of your life, what things would they conclude you prioritize most?**

How does remembering Christ pursued you, died for you, guides you, and is with you every step of the way, impact your parenting? If you are not a parent, how does remembering Christ impact your most important relationships?
