Read Proverbs 6:16-19

What part of the sermon or passage stood out to you the most, and why?

Proverbs 6:16–19 says there are things that God "hates" and that are an "abomination" to Him. **Why do you think we sometimes feel uncomfortable talking about what God hates?**

Which of the seven sins do you personally find yourself needing to guard against most right now? What makes that one particularly challenging? (*pride, lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, heart that devises wicked plans, feet that pursue evil, sowing discord among brothers*)

What does God's hatred of these sins reveal about His character specifically?

What do you think of this statement, "Every deed God hates was aimed at Jesus and instead of God's wrath falling on those who committed them, the Father placed them all on His Son"?

Pat repeatedly said, "*Because God loves us, He hates what destroys what He loves.*" **How does that statement change the way you think about God's commands?**

God hates "haughty eyes" or pride. **What are some everyday situations where pride creeps into your life?**

Solomon calls us to "hate what God hates and love what God loves." **What is one practical way you can pursue that this week?**

Have a time of sharing. (i.e. Share highs/lows in this season, needs in your home/community, etc.)
