Optional Ice Breaker: What is the wisest piece of advice or the most foolish advice you have ever received?

Read Proverbs 8

What part of the sermon or passage stood out to you the most, and why?

If someone looked at your calendar, relationships, entertainment, conversations, and habits, would they conclude that you are actively seeking wisdom? Why or why not?

To hate evil is taking on the attitude of God toward the evil that defames God's glory and ruins the lives of people that He loves. **How is this definition of hating evil different from the world's definition of hatred?**

Justin said one of our fundamental problems is, "we haven't let ourselves be awed by God." **What do you think of that statement? What steals your awe from God? What makes you feel in awe of God?**

Wisdom lines up with how God made the world to be so we flourish as we live wisely. **Share in your life where you have experienced the flourishing result of choosing God's way of wisdom?** (*ex: marriage, finances, vocation, a hard conversation, family, etc.*)

Justin said we have to choose to pursue wisdom. **In what ways are you committed to choosing wisdom after this message?**

The sermon ends by pointing us to Jesus as the embodiment of God's wisdom. **How does knowing that wisdom is ultimately found in a Person—Jesus—rather than merely in principles or information change the way you think about pursuing wisdom?**
