Topic: It's time for a Change
Matthew 3:1-3 NIV
Revelation 2:1-7 KJV

We are in a season of preparation as the body of Christ. God wants to take us deeper. There's more to church than just church. He wants us to experience greater levels in Him. But are we truly ready? If Jesus were to come back right now today, would you be ready?

The church has lost her zeal for God. We get excited for everything else, but the church has lost its zeal for God. We were created to be His hands and feet, but we are at a crippled state. We don't have to stay in that condition. We've relied so much on our humanity that we've used that as an excuse to not come up to the next level in God. But it's time to stop playing church, and time to be the church. It's time for a change.

If we're doing things without God, what are we doing?

God is calling each and everyone of us to rise up. God has an assignment for us and this is the season of preparation. We can see the signs. But God is preparing the church for the days ahead. We have to be uncomfortable in the season. We can't allow ourselves to get complacent. We've made God our personal genie, settling for seeking His hand and not seeking His face. We don't want to crown Him as Lord, because if we do that we'd have to get off social media that much and take time to get in His word and study. But we don't want to do that, we want to doomscroll and get in everybody's business. But we've got to carve out time to seek His face and learn His word.

We've got to get back to biblical things of God. We can't depend and lean on our own understanding. The word of God is life to us. We have to interrupt our regularly scheduled program and go back to the things of God. Invite God in, put him first so He can command your day. Make God your priority in this season.
