5 Types of pearls:

- * Akoya - Famous for its round shape and size
- * South Sea- are known to be larger, and are often white or golden
- * Titanium- famous for its black and grey tones
- * Fresh water- is the most common, and are grown in lakes and rivers
- * Mother- Looks like how you speak life.

Pearls are formed through irritation, pressure, patience, and time.

1. The first stage of a pearl being born is called irritation. This is the beginning of the struggle for mothers.

Jeremiah 1:5 KJV. Sometimes the beginning of a person's story feels painful and disruptive.

Point 1 God often starts his greatest works in broken places.

1. 1 Samuel 1:27 KJV
2. The second stage is called the oyster covers the pearls.
 1. Isaiah 49:15 KJV
 2. Exodus 2:2 KJV

Point 2 - Prayer becomes protection and faith becomes covering.

1. The Third stage is called Pressure. Pressure can bring the breaking point. Romans 5:3 KJV. Ruth 1:20 KJV.

Point 3- Pressure does not mean God has abandoned you. Sometimes the darkest seasons become the birthing place for transformation. Pressure also becomes the place where something breaks

1. The fourth stage is called transformation. Proverbs 22:6 KJV.

Point 4- The seeds planted by faithful parents may sleep for years, but they are never Dead. God knows how to awaken the purpose at the right time.

Luke 2:19 KJV

1. Stage Five. The pearl has become finished.

Proverbs 31:28 KJV

Esther 4:4 KJV

Point 5 - Mother Pearls - God redeems pain so that someone else can be redeemed by our testimony.
