What is a true Friend?

People who have a lot of friends are healthy. Having a lot of good friends gives you a long life, and gives you an opportunity to express yourself.

A good friend is someone who makes you feel good about yourself and who you are. They are willing to apologize and admit when they're wrong. They have time for you and are present when needed. They support through challenges without keeping a strict scorecard.

Toxic Friends are people that give you knots in your stomach.

When people are jealous of your anointing, they aren't good friends.

2 Samuel 6:16 Michal based her and David's marriage off of being Saul's daughter.

2 Samuel 6:20 Michal didn't love David like she thought she did. Some people love their position/title more than they love God.

A true friend is one that is dedicated, devoted, and enthusiastic about your success.

1 Samuel 20:4
