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What is Jesus doing in Heaven Today?

Act 7:54 KJV

Mark 16:19 KJV

Acts said that Steven saw Jesus Standing on the Right hand of God. But Mark said that Jesus is seated at the right hand of God. Is there a contradiction in the Bible?

Clarification

Isaiah 59:2 KJV. The Father wanted to keep up the relationship with his creation but sin separated him from his people. But, to ensure that the communion with God and his creation would endure God instituted that priesthood. His job was to stand in the gap between God and sinful man. How? By Animal sacrifice. It was not God's perfect Will, but by his permissive will.

Hebrews 10:6 KJV. This was a system that God started for the priesthood to cover the sins of man for that year. Priesthood came through Aaron (the first high priest) The tribe of Levi was chosen (Exodus/Leviticus/Numbers) to assist him in the tabernacle transporting the parts, setting it up and taking it down. Aaron being the High Priest, was only allowed once a year to go into the Holy of Holies. Inside the Tent of the Tabernacle [see] the big white curtain was around the big area [tent] that's called the outer court. Two rooms inside that area were called the Holy Place and the Holies of Holies. The Holy place is where the ministers could go into daily replacing the bread and oil. But only once a year could the high priest (At this time Aaron) go behind the veil (the Holies of Holies).

Hebrews 9:7 KJV. He [The High Priest] Had to offer blood and make sure that his sin was covered before going into the Holies of Holies. Inside the Holies of Holies is the Ark of the covenant. On top of it are two arch angels with their wings spread representing the presence of God. After making himself a sacrifice, the high priest can enter the Holies of Holies, with the blood from the bulls and goats. The high priest wasn't allowed to stand still in the presence of God but had to walk around. He had a bell on one leg to let the people outside know that he was still alive, and a rope on the other in case he wasn't right with God so that the people could pull him out, because they weren't allowed in. When he finished in the Holies of Holies he would come out and they had a chair on the right side of the entrance and he'd sit in the chair and cross his legs. This signified to the people that his work was finished. If someone (one of the people came late to the sacrifice) He couldn't just get up and go back in.

But the bible reminds us that this isn't God's perfect will.

Hebrews 8:7 KJV This is what God used to show Israel his holiness and how to approach him. Hebrews 10:1 KJV

The animal sacrifices did **nothing** for the conscious of men

Hebrews 9:9 KJV they got so a

*** A Job not Finished**

John 19:30 KJV. His [Jesus] part, being the sacrificial lamb, for the sin of man was completed but his job continued on. He had satisfied God as a man by dying a sin-less death.

Romans 8:3-4 KJV. The law is God's standard for man, but man messed it up. The law was not to justify man but it was like a mirror to show man his sin. God is the only one that can justify

you. Romans 8:4. What does that mean? Because of Jesus, all 613 laws you and I have kept through Jesus Christ. God is no longer upset/angry with us, and we are no longer enemies of God. We have fulfilled the law. John 20:17 KJV.

John 16:7 KJV. 1 Peter 3:22

***But Now what is His assignment**

1 John 2:1 AMP. Jesus Job is multi-faceted
He's seated at the right of God signifying his supreme authority and vindication of his redemptive work. He's advocating for you, before God ensuring open communication between humanity and God. He's interceding for us, presenting our needs and petitions before the Father. He's praying for us, knowing all about our needs and heartaches. Jesus is engaging in spiritual advocacy, his ongoing ministry through the Holy Spirit continues to work in our hearts and lives empowering us to do the work commissioned of us.

But what about Jesus Standing.

When John (The baptizer, Jesus's Cousin) was killed, the Jews sinned against the Father, when they asked Pilate to kill Jesus they sinned against the Son of God, when they stoned Stephen, Israel sinned against the Holy Spirit who was working in and through the Apostle. Jesus said that this sin could never be forgiven. But why was Jesus standing? There are many schools of thought on this concept. Acts 7:54 KJV. Some say that Jesus was standing to welcome the first Christian martyr into heaven, some say that Jesus was standing in heaven because Stephen was standing for Him on earth. We won't hypothesize what Jesus Standing meant, we'll just see what the Word says.
