

Passage Option Fall 2022

Colossians 1:15-16 (CSB)

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For everything was created by him, in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities— all things have been created through him and for him.

Colossians 1:17-18 (CSB)

He is before all things, and by him all things hold together. He is also the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that he might come to have first place in everything.

Colossians 1:19-20 (CSB)

For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile everything to himself, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

Colossians 2:6-7 (CSB)

So then, just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to walk in him, being rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude.

Colossians 2:9-10 (CSB)

For the entire fullness of God's nature dwells bodily in Christ, and you have been filled by him, who is the head over every ruler and authority.

Colossians 2:11 (CSB)

You were also circumcised in him with a circumcision not done with hands, by putting off the body of flesh, in the circumcision of Christ,

Colossians 2:12 (CSB)

when you were buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.

Colossians 2:13 (CSB)

And when you were dead in trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, he made you alive with him and forgave us all our trespasses.

Colossians 2:14 (CSB)

He erased the certificate of debt, with its obligations, that was against us and opposed to us, and has taken it away by nailing it to the cross.

John 8:7b (CSB)

7 he stood up and said to them, “The one without sin among you should be the first to throw a stone at her.”

Luke 2:30-32 (CSB)

30 For my eyes have seen your salvation. You have prepared it in the presence of all peoples—a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory to your people Israel.

John 4:14 (CSB)

14 But whoever drinks from the water that I will give him will never get thirsty again. In fact, the water I will give him will become a well of water springing up in him for eternal life.”

John 1:29 or 3:30 (CSB)

*1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
3:30 He must increase, but I must decrease.*

John 9:25b (CSB)

25b “Whether or not he’s a sinner, I don’t know. One thing I do know: I was blind, and now I can see!”

Matthew 6:21 (CSB)

21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Matthew 4:4 or 4:10 (CSB)

*4 He answered, “It is written: Man must not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.”
10 Then Jesus told him, “Go away, Satan! For it is written: Worship the Lord your God, and serve only him.”*

John 3:3 or 5-6 (CSB)

*3 Jesus replied, “Truly I tell you, unless someone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”
5-6 Jesus answered, “Truly I tell you, unless someone is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. Whatever is born of the flesh is flesh, and whatever is born of the Spirit is spirit.*

Luke 10:41-42 (NIV)

10:41-42 “Martha, Martha,” the Lord answered, “you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her.”

Psalms 27:4 (NIV)

27:4 One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple.

Luke 8:48 (CSB)

48 “Daughter,” he said to her, “your faith has saved you. Go in peace.”
