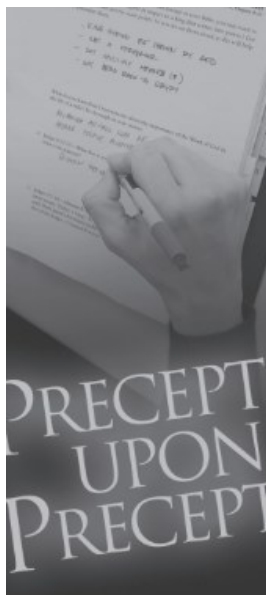

Prayers for Schools

Matthew 18:18–20

18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

19 Again I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

Protection

May the Lord bless and keep all the children and adults in our school district. May the Lord make His face to shine upon them and be gracious, kind, merciful and give them favor. May the Lord turn His face to them and give them peace. (Num. 6:24-26)

Lord, we put on the armor of God and stand against Satan with all the power and authority that the name and the blood of Jesus has bought for us. (1John 1:9) (Eph. 6:11-18)

Heavenly Father, we look to you for help! We declare that our help and safety come from You and only You. We ask You to watch over every aspect of our schools continuously. As our children, teachers, and administrators come on campus each day, keep them under Your protective shade. Keep them from all harm and watch over them and the campuses day and night. (Ps. 121 NLT)

In the name of Jesus, we stop every demonic assignment of Satan to steal, kill, or destroy our school-attending children and their teachers and school personnel (John 10:10). Salvation and Revival

Lord, pour out your Spirit that they may all come to know you as their Lord and Savior, in Jesus' name we pray. (Isa. 44:3) (Joel 2:28,29)

Wisdom, Favor, Strength for Teachers and Administrators

Father, give the teachers strength and a spirit of endurance knowing that their efforts will be rewarded. (Gal. 6:9) Lord, we ask for your protection, peace, wisdom, joy, and discernment for the faculty and staff of this school. (1 Thes. 5:24) Give them wisdom in every circumstance that they face and let patience and love rule and reign in their hearts. (James 1:5) (1 Cor. 16:14) (Col. 3:12)

Students

Lord, we decree that all our students are wise and accept discipline from their teachers and administrators as well as their parents. (Prov. 15:5)

We declare that the students in this school will show proper respect for the authorities You have placed over them, and recognize all authority comes from You. Help them to speak and act in a way that is respectful of all teachers, administrators, and other school staff. (Rom. 13:1-5)

Father, give each student a hunger and thirst for knowledge, and opportunities to reach their full potential and fulfill their God given destiny. (Ps. 119:66) (Eccl. 2:26a)

Give them the ability to concentrate and be diligent in all every subject area. Reveal to each one the giftings and talents that You have placed within them so they may begin to work toward fulfilling their gifts and callings.

Father, we pray that each student will develop healthy relationships with their peers, and that You will give each one wisdom when choosing friends. (Prov. 17:17a)

We decree that all forms of bullying will be uncovered, exposed and stopped in our schools so that no student is afraid, or made to feel inferior or alone. (Heb. 4:13)

Lord, we ask that every student in our school district would experience some form of success this school year, whether it be in academics, friendships, relationships with teachers, or physically or athletically. We pray that peace would permeate their hearts and minds and that each student would not only grow physically but spiritually in You, Father. (Ps. 118:25) (1 Pet. 2:2) (2 Pet. 3:18)

Peace, Provision, and Blessings

Lord, we declare that a Spirit of Peace will rule and reign over every school, the administration building, every student, and every adult in our school district. (Ps. 147:14a)

Father, we ask that if any student or adult becomes anxious or fearful about anything they will realize that they can come to You with thanksgiving and ask for what they need. You have not given them that fear or anxiety, but it has come from the enemy. Thank you, that when they do come to You, Your peace will cover and guard their hearts and minds. (Phil. 4: 6,7)

Lord, because our school district is so faithful to give all they have and all that they are to our students, we ask You to supply all their needs according to Your riches in glory in Christ Jesus. (Phil. 4:19)

Father, let Your favor and blessings rest upon our superintendent as the head of our school district, and let them flow down to all personnel and students. Work with them so that they will be successful in all they do because Your word tells us that, "now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation." (Ps. 90:17 TPT) (2 Cor. 6:2b)
