Sermon Series

Faith in Fiction: The Stories That Read Us Back July 5–26

Long before Jesus told a parable, God was telling stories. Scripture, it turns out, is mostly narrative—and the people who wrote it understood what we sometimes forget: a story can carry the weight of truth in a way that an argument never can. Great fiction works the same way. It rehearses us, in the quiet, for the moments our own lives will eventually ask of us—when grace arrives disguised as a stranger, when forgiveness costs more than we can afford, when sacrifice is asked of us before we feel ready. We'll discover that the greatest stories are not finally about us—but about the God who has been telling them all along.
