Behavior Agreement

Awana is a Bible club where the children learn lessons from the Bible, memorize Scripture, sing, and play games. There is a lot of activity, and this requires a high level of cooperation from the children.

Behavior Expectations

- Behave in a respectful, obedient manner to adults.
- Treat other children with respect.
- Walk, not run, through the halls.
- Quiet down quickly when instructed by adults.
- Stay with your class or team throughout all activities. You are encouraged but not required to participate in all activities. If you choose not to participate, you must still stay with your group and be respectful of those who want to participate.
- Because there is great potential for children to be exposed to objectionable material, **cell phones are not allowed to be out or used**. They must be kept silent in a pocket or bag or given to an adult to hold for the evening. Please contact Pastor Job if you need to get ahold of your child.
- All toys need to be left at home. If they are brought to Awana, an adult will hold it until it is time to leave.
- Food should only be eaten while sitting at a table in the assigned room. Food is not allowed to be eaten in the hallways or bathrooms.
- Children should try to use the bathroom before classes begin so as not to disrupt the lessons. We will allow children to use the bathroom when needed, however, if we notice they are going more frequently than expected, we will contact you to see if there is a medical issue. If your child has a medical issue, please let us know so we can make sure they are escorted to the bathroom as needed.

Consequences for Poor Behavior

- Minor infractions will be handled by an adult reminding the child of the expectations.
- Major infractions or continual minor misbehavior will result in parents being contacted and the behavior documented.
- If a child continually misbehaves after consulting with parents or if the child refuses to respond to correction, the child may be suspended for a set time at the discretion of the Awana Director or Children's Pastor.
- Continuing problems may result in expulsion.

We desire to give much grace and give each child an opportunity to learn and have fun. Please help us in this effort.
