A FAMILY EQUIPPING MINISTRY

SAFETY

At BBC, we take our stewardship of your children seriously. Here are just a few of the procedures we have in place to ensure their safety:

- Mandatory volunteer and leader background checks
- Mandatory safety training for volunteers and leaders
- Security cameras and lockdown systems
- Security team presence during service times
- Our open door policy ensures children are not left alone with an adult behind closed doors.
- Check-in system to track allergy information and facilitate child-to-parent pickup

Check-in

Our BBC check-in kiosk helps us keep track of allergy information and ensures safe and secure child drop off and pickup.



First time Check-in:

- Take your child to the *Nursery* desk, where he/she will be taken to their appropriate room.
- Communicate any pertinent allergy/medical information to the receptionist and receive a ticket.
- Fill out an information sheet. The next time you check your child in, you will receive a scanner card assigned to you for all future check-in use.

Subsequent Check-in:

- Place personal scanner card under scanner, barcode side up.
- Select child(ren) you wish to check in.
- Beside each child's name, select which event he/she is being checked into.
- Select "Complete Check In."
- Please retrieve adhesive printout and attach one part to child(ren).

Check-out

- Go to the *Nursery* desk and place scanner card under scanner, barcode side up.
- The name of your child(ren) who are checked in should appear. Select child(ren) you wish to check out.
- Once child(ren) are selected, select the green button entitled, "Check Out Tagged."

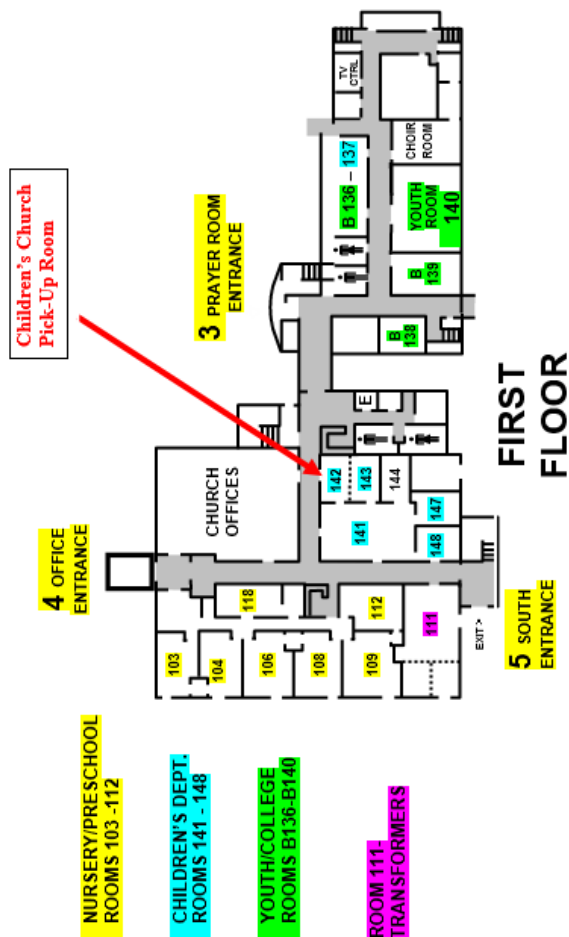
A typical class outline is as follows:

Broadway 101 - Introduction to Broadway Baptist Church

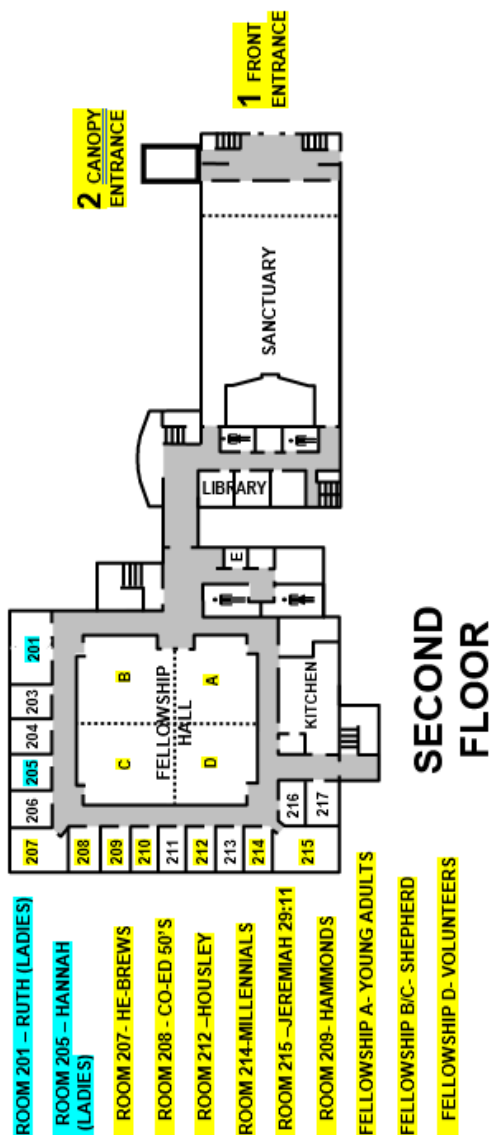
1. Who is Jesus?
