Truth Principles Verses 18-20

Psalm 41 shows the principle of God’s mercy for those merciful to the afflicted and God’s punishment for those who feign friendship yet later betray and afflict the weak or suffering.

Jesus is God and is _____! He knew David’s prayer in Psalm 41:9 would prophetically be fulfilled that night when one of the twelve disciples would betray Jesus.

Jesus knew this prophecy would later help His disciples solidify their belief that God had _____.

Christ and His Sender are _____ (10:30). The two are inseparable, therefore to accept one and reject the other is to reject both! Any who reject Christ-believers who are proclaiming the salvation message of being reconciled to God through Christ are rejecting Christ Himself.

The Betrayer Revealed Verses 21-30

Because of what He had said (Verses 6-20) and in view of what He was about to say, Jesus became agitated and distressed. He then declared that which He already knew: that the betrayer would be _____!

Peter motioned for John to ask Jesus who was the betrayer. Jesus revealed that the one who would betray Him was he whom he gave the dipped bread. It would be Jesus’ last extension of _____ to Judas.

Judas dismissed warnings and truths from Jesus, leading him to succumb to the evil temptations and schemes of the devil. Rejecting opportunities to believe in Jesus he had reached a point of no return. Satan _____ him.

Though one might pretend to know Jesus through religious actions and affiliation with believers, ultimately Jesus will cast the merely religious out into the dark.
