John focuses very little on documenting the procession or crucifixion of Jesus. Verses 17-18

- The victim was forced to _____ the crossbeam (patibulum) to the waiting vertical post (the stipes).
- The victim was usually tied to the cross; however, the executioner could hasten death by using _____.

Pilate's sign on the cross essentially read, "The king of the Jews crucified at the request of the Jews; let the whole world know this." Eternally, this sign declares the King and Savior's sacrificial salvation for the whole _____. Verses 19-22; John 3:16-17; Romans 11:15

The four soldiers cast lots and divided the handmade clothes of Jesus. This fulfilled Psalm 22:18, one of _____ distinct Old Testament prophecies fulfilled in Christ. Verses 23-24

John mentions four women remaining/abiding with Christ in courage and love. Attentive to _____ prophecy about His mother (Luke 2:35), and seeing John there by her side, Jesus entrusted His mother's care to John. Verses 25-27

In fulfillment of another Scripture (either Psalm 22:15 or 69:21) Jesus asked for something to drink. Using a hyssop branch to lift a sponge up to Jesus visualized the believing Jews dipping hyssop branches in the blood of their sacrificed lambs and applying it to their doorposts and lintels. Verses 28-29; Exodus 12:21-24

Jesus cried out, "It is finished," declaring He had "paid in full" the world's _____ of _____. Then Jesus gave over His spirit in death, again revealing that no man took His life.
