6. **Giving Sight to a Blind Man** - John 9:1-41 - Jesus causes or removes physical and spiritual _____ based on faith.
7. **Raising Lazarus from the Dead** - John 11:1-57 - As Lord of eternal life, Jesus has power even over _____.
