Role Summary

- Supports guests by providing safe, organized, and welcoming parking, assisting where needed, and helping the Serve Team fulfill its purpose and advance the RADIUS mission.

Responsibilities

- Serve as scheduled.
- Arrive ___ **minutes** before service time (as determined by your campus).
- Assist with setup, service, and breakdown of parking areas.
- Set up traffic cones, welcome signs, and other needed equipment.
- Follow team assignments to ensure all areas are covered.
- Support traffic flow and maintain safety standards.
- Provide rain assistance (umbrellas, walking guests under cover), as determined by campus.
- Greet guests warmly and help when needed (e.g., helping parents with children).
- Demonstrate patience and kindness with guests, responding graciously to any parking mistakes.
- Assist handicapped guests by directing them to designated parking areas (look for handicap plates or mirror tags).
- Participate in weekly huddles.
- Wear assigned lanyard with name tag while serving, as determined by campus.
- Respond to schedule requests and communication using the church's designated platform.
- Volunteers are responsible for communicating with team lead if they cannot serve as scheduled.

What Success Looks Like

- Guests experience safe, organized, and welcoming parking.
- Team members follow assigned positions and traffic flow plan.
- Guests feel genuinely cared for through friendly, proactive engagement (e.g., helping families, carrying items, or providing rain support).

Role Summary

- Leads and equips the Parking Team to provide safe, organized, and welcoming parking for guests, ensuring smooth operations while supporting the Serve Team purpose and advancing the RADIUS mission.

Responsibilities

- Shepherds volunteers by:
 - Connecting with them.
 - Discovering where they are in their spiritual journey.
 - Guiding them by providing or facilitating intentional discipleship and care.
- Serve weekly.
- Arrive ___ **minutes** before service time.
- Oversee parking team during setup, service, and breakdown.
- Manage the setup of traffic cones, welcome signs, and related equipment.
- Assist with coordinating volunteers for special non-Sunday events (e.g., Christmas Eve, The Well, Easter).
- Assign team members to positions and ensure full coverage.
- Implement traffic flow plan and maintain safety standards.
- Recruit, onboard, and mentor new Parking volunteers as needed.
- Participate in weekly huddles.
- Maintain serve schedule and confirm coverage.
- Use the church's designated platform for scheduling and communication.
- Ensure team provides rain assistance (umbrellas, walking guests under cover), as determined by campus.
- Team engages guests after parking with a warm greeting and offers assistance when needed.
- Wear assigned lanyard with name tag while serving, as determined by campus.

What Success Looks Like

- Parking areas are safe, organized, and fully staffed.
- Guests feel welcomed and assisted as needed.
- Team members are trained, scheduled, and confident in their roles.
- Schedules and coverage are maintained accurately.
