**Bethany Family,**

We have been so busy around here at Bethany Church; moving our offices, clearing out closets, and making changes! It is both wonderful and stressful at the same time. We are making progress on our Welcome Center project. Walls are being torn out of the old offices, and the committee is making decisions on furniture and other details. Sometimes we can get lost in the details of major projects like this and forget about what God is doing in and around us. I want to be careful not to make that mistake!

We are actively getting ready for our summer outreach initiatives. VBS is right around the corner and so are the Summer Playdates. As we gear up for these wonderful outreach opportunities, I am reminded that we also have our baptism celebration coming up in July. We will gather together as a church family after church on July 19th at Lake Latonka to celebrate all that God has been doing. It will be a time of fun, food, and celebration. So mark your calendars!

I also wonder if some of you may want to be a more direct part of the celebration. Perhaps you are a believer in Jesus Christ but have never been baptized. Maybe you meant to be baptized but never got around to it. Or maybe you are unsure about what baptism is and why it matters.

**Baptism is a physical and communal opportunity to identify with Jesus as your Lord and Savior. It is a declaration that you believe in Jesus and have received the Holy Spirit, that you are reborn and renewed by the blood of Christ. It signifies that you have repented (turned away) from your sins. It is a public proclamation that Jesus is Lord of your life, meaning He has the right to guide you, redirect you, and lead your life. It is also a willing submission to His authority as God. It's a big deal!**

**Baptism is modeled by Jesus (Matthew 3:13–17; Mark 1:9–11; Luke 3:21–22) and is a command given to us (Matthew 28:19–20). A command to be baptized and to go and baptize others. If you have never been baptized, no matter the reason, we would love to baptize you during our baptism celebration on July 19th. We would be honored to celebrate the hope and transformation God has brought to your life as a Christian.**

**We will also offer an opportunity for rededication during this celebration. A rededication is similar to baptism in that you go under the water, but instead of being baptized again, you are publicly declaring that God is working in a new way in your life. It is a renewed commitment to Jesus. This is available to anyone who has already been baptized, whether as an adult or as an infant. Has God been doing something new in your life? This may be a meaningful way to share that and rededicate your life to Christ.**

#### Ministry Updates and Current Projects

- **SmartBox (Rokassa Senior Secondary School) (FULLY FUNDED)** Training begins this week for a new SmartBox system—providing educational resources and WASSCE practice exams. We are excited about the impact this will have on student success.
- **Latrine Construction (FULLY FUNDED)**  
Three new latrines are being built (two in Rokassa, one in Mapainda), improving sanitation and dignity for students and families.  
Thank you to our church partners who donated to these projects!
- **Mayatta Teachers' Quarters (PARTIALLY FUNDED)**  
Construction is underway to provide housing for our teachers.

We still need \$12,000 to complete the project and \$5,500 for solar installation.

We hope to finish before the rainy season begins.

Please prayerfully consider how your church might help.

We could not do this work without you, and we are deeply grateful for the ways you give, pray, and walk alongside us in this mission.

# YoungLife

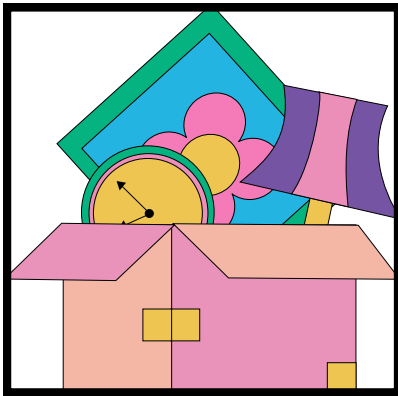
Our annual Penn West Young Life Fundraising Banquet was amazing! We enjoyed celebrating and sharing the many stories of the Lord's faithfulness together!

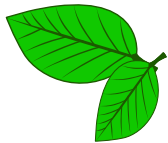
