

Bethany Church has a rich history of caring for family and youth throughout the Mercer area.

A playground is also a powerful statement to the broader Mercer community that we care about children. It's a statement that will bring a positive perspective of Bethany Church to people who might not specifically know us. We recently posted pictures of the playground on Facebook and the post "reached" over 3,000 people. Eight hundred people clicked on the post to read more about it and eighty people commented. Finally, it resulted in two new kids signing up for VBS!

The playground will bring opportunity for outreach. We plan to have public hours where people in the community are welcome to use the playground. It is the only playground in the downtown area and will attract attention and interest throughout the day. As a soft tool for outreach, we can have information about our church available at the playground with some seating for parents.





For those of us who are in the church throughout the day, it will generate opportunities to talk with parents as they bring their kids to the playground. Finally, it can be used as a tool to build relationships with people. For example, it is our intention to host play dates for kids and their parents from VBS. These play dates will be a bridge to build relationships between church members and non church members. In time, we believe it will result in having more VBS families come visit Bethany and stay at Bethany because they have built relationships here before they even attend a Sunday morning service. When strategically used, the playground will be a conduit for outreach opportunities, a symbol of our commitment to children, and a positive reminder of how Bethany Church is a blessing to the Mercer community.


