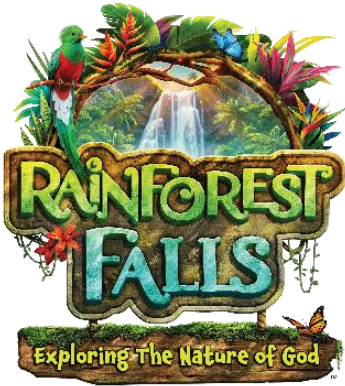
Endowment Funds Distribution
