SUNDAY SERVICES

Our services are normally about 75 minutes long and involve worship in song, prayer, and teaching from the Bible. Most of our people stand with the worship team when we sing, but we encourage you to enter into worship in whatever posture is comfortable for you.

Natural, pertaining to the natural as distinguished from the spiritual or glorified nature of man. 1 Cor. 15:44 refers to a body psuchikón, a body governed by the soul or natural and fallen instinct of man

#4152. Pneumatikós; ... from pneúma (G4151), spirit. Spiritual.

(I) Pertaining to the nature of spirits. "A spiritual body" (1 Cor. 15:44) means a body dominated by the Spirit, in contrast to a natural or soulish body (sóma psuchikón [sóma {G4983}, body; psuchikón {G5591}, pertaining to soul]) which obeys one's natural instincts or soul.
