Just weeks after the accident one of our pilots/flight instructors suffered a severe stroke and was airlifted to Anchorage for surgery. There will be a long road of recovery for him and it is unknown if he will be able to fly again, however, considering the severity of the stroke he has made a remarkable recovery, is home, and has already started to work in the shop part-time. Please pray for him, his wife, and their five young children as they continue on the road of recovery.
