OVERVIEW

In this simple catechism lesson, Greybobby and friends explore the Redemption Lands, where they find a beautiful garden and meet a mysterious Gardener who helps them learn that Jesus is God's Son and our Savior. He is fully God and fully human.

JOHN 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

WHAT DID WE LEARN?

- The most important question we can ever ask is this: Who is Jesus?
- And the answer is the most important truth we can ever know: Jesus is God's Son and our Savior. He is fully God and fully human.
- That means Jesus isn't just a good teacher or a nice story. He is truly God—powerful enough to save us, and truly human—able to come close to us and stand in our place.
- He came into the world because God loves us, just like we heard in John 3:16, so that anyone who believes in Him will have eternal life.
- We also learned that sometimes God helps us discover the truth by asking questions and leading us step by step. And just like a good gardener, He plants truth in our hearts so it can grow.

Plant Your truth deep in our hearts so it will grow and bear good fruit in our lives.

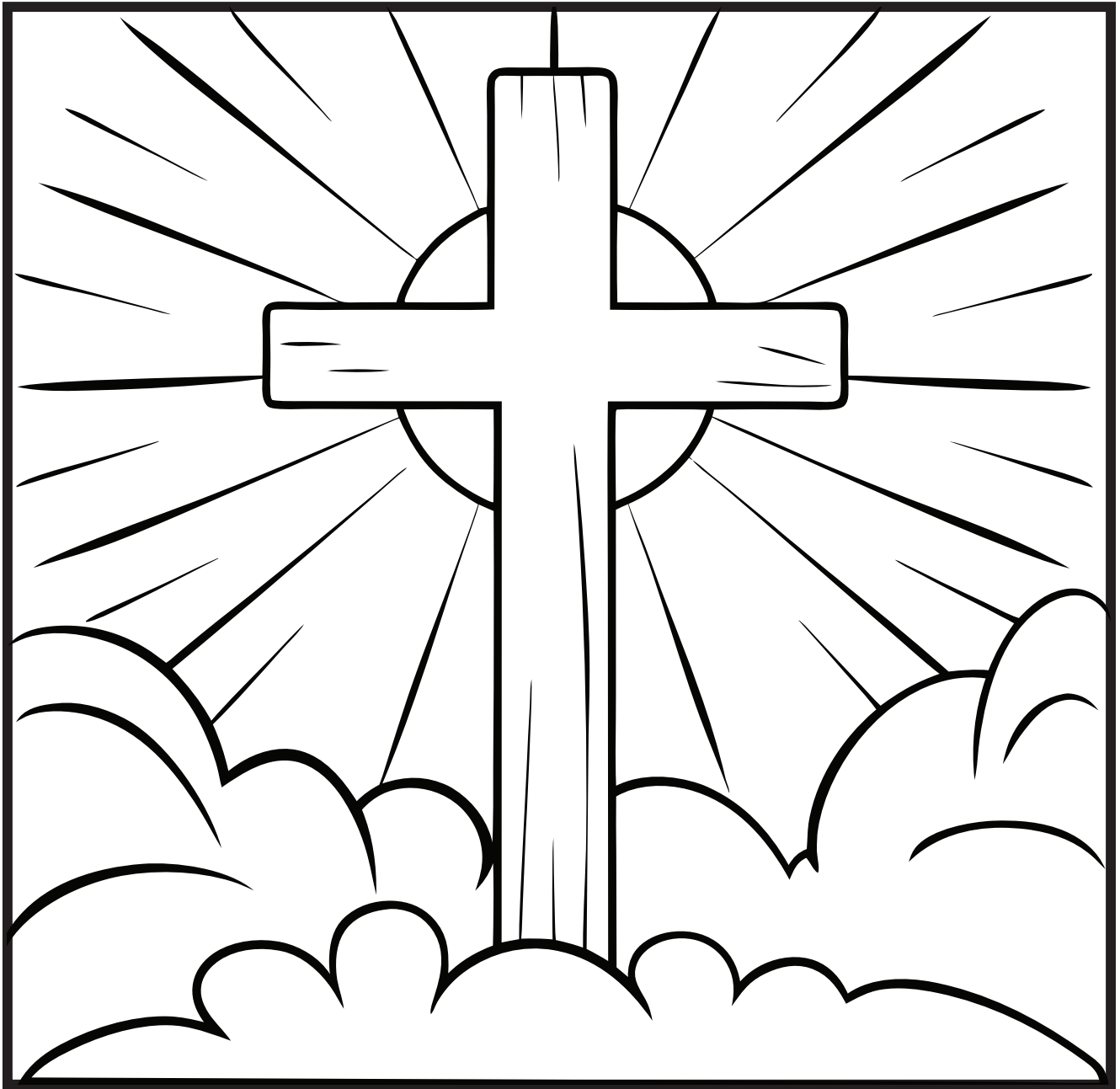
