Evangelism Training #3 - Tips For Witnessing

Matthew 28:19-20 ¹⁹“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”

- We go with Jesus' authority - Our mission is backed by the risen King
- Make disciples - A long process of converting, baptizing, and teaching followers to imitate Jesus Christ
- All nations - Every ethnic group. (Ac. 1:8) Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, the remotest part.
- Baptize in the Trinity - We have Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Submission to the Godhead
- Don't just give information - Teach disciples to obey Jesus' commands. Your life changes
- Jesus' presence is promised - He will be with us to the end. We can't do it without Him.

How do you disciple someone after they receive Christ?

Six Aspects of Discipleship

1. Establish a gender-specific relational connection - Meet regularly. Build trust. Share life.
2. Teach basic spiritual disciplines - Find a good resource like Navigator's.
3. Read the Bible together - Learn about Jesus from the gospel of John.
4. Teach them how to pray - Prayer is communication with God. Model it. Let them do it.
5. Focus on obedience and growth - Use the 'Nine Marks of Discipleship' at CBC (below).
6. Get in community - Find a local church and connect to other believers in small group

Tips

1. Be patient - It will be one step forward and two steps back.
2. Be consistent - Commit to a weekly meeting and never miss it.
3. Be authentic - Share your current sin struggles and how you rely on God's grace.
