

Thank you for your interest in our church yard sale. Below you will find everything you need to know about donating, volunteering and all the opportunities to shop!

Drop offs

Wednesday 9/30 3:00-6:00PM Sunday 10/4 3:00-6:00PM

Wednesday 10/7 3:00-6:00PM Sunday 10/11 12:00-6:00PM (last drop off)

We accept donations in the gym area found at the back of the church near the activity field. Please mark your boxes with contents. Clothes can be left on hangers or put in a bag. Please no soiled or torn clothing. Do not bring items in containers that need to be returned.

We cannot accept paint, mattresses/box springs, boxed/tubed TVs, unframed mirrors or glass, guns or ammunition, car seats. Please refrain from donating broken items.

No children under 12 can work due to safety reasons during drop off OR set up. Children 13-16 must be with a parent or guardian during drop AND/OR set up.

Pick ups

If you need a pickup (this is defined as someone without a truck), this needs to be scheduled with our coordinator, Sam Franco, 706-495-7337. Due to limited volunteers, we may not be able to accommodate all requests. For safety reasons, we cannot move items from upstairs. These pickups are not for household items, FURNITURE only.

During the hours listed above we will be unpacking and sorting items. Please see a committee member prior to marking items.

Drinks and snacks will be available during drop-offs and set up. Starting Monday, 10/5- Wednesday 10/14, lunch will be provided. If you would like to provide a meal for everyone, please let someone on the committee know when. If you have any dietary needs, please let us know as well.

Volunteer sale Thursday 10/15 5:00-7:00PM

Gold wristbands-20 volunteer hours. Shopping starts at 5:00. No children are allowed until 6:15 unless in strollers with parent. To earn guest wristband, you must work 30 hours. For every 10 hours after your 20 hours, you get 1 guest wristband. (40 hours= 1 gold +2 guest) These wristbands are only valid on Thursday.

Blue wristbands-11-19 volunteer hours, shopping starts at 6:00PM

Red wristbands-guest who have been given hours from another volunteer shop at 6:15PM

Wristbands will be distributed starting on Wednesday and after 3:00 until time of entry.

Presale Friday 10/16 5:00PM-7:00PM

For a \$20/\$25 cash donation, you can shop early! Children 12 and younger are free with parent or guardian. They are \$20 but ANY SOLD STARTING Sunday, 10/11 WILL BE \$25! For this event, we will only have 200 wristbands available. They can be obtained at each drop-off starting 9/30, all set up times and church office during business hours.

Yard Sale Saturday 10/17 7:00AM-12:00PM

This sale is open to everyone. We need volunteers to work this sale. If you are interested, please let someone on the committee know. We ask if you're volunteering to be at the gym by 6:30AM. Wear a yard sale T-shirt. Sign in and ask what area you need to help in. These hours worked today go toward the next sale!

After Sale Saturday 10/17 1:00PM-3:00PM \$10 cash donation, except for the yard sale fixtures and tables, you can take anything that is left over inside and outside. You may come and go as many times as you want. You will need to plan to load your goods and furniture in your car. There will not be any volunteers available to help.

Clean Up Sunday 3/16 12:00PM until. The gym will be open at 10:00AM if there's anything left, get it for FREE!!! We need volunteers to help clean up and those hours will go toward the next sale.
