What a great summer we've experienced at Wesley. There has been remodeling around our campus, and it all looks great. This week's work was completed - refurbishing the Prayer Room by the Sanctuary so it can also be used as a Mom's Room during worship to serve families with infants and young children. Have you noticed? More and more young families are visiting our church, and this space will provide a calm and relaxing place for moms to comfort infants while remaining connected to worship.

If you've been away the last few weeks, note the new Ministries building out back that will house the building of wheelchair ramps and our mechanics ministry. Speaking of ministering to the needs of our community, during the month of August we will be highlighting our ReStart ministry that provides beds and bedding for families throughout the CSRA. On Sunday, August 16, we will celebrate the building and delivery of 4,000 beds through this ministry. What an accomplishment, and what a difference this ministry has made! On the that day, you will be invited to help in the construction of another bed and see all that this great ministry is about. Put the date on your calendar and plan to be with us in worship on that day. In addition to mission ministries to our local area, we have also sent students and adults to Guatemala and students to Hinton Rural Life Center in North Carolina.

However, that is not all. Each week in the summer, we have hosted a camp at Wesley. Maybe best of all has been our Theater Camp under the leadership of Luke Amerson. Each day 30 or more children have been engaged in rehearsal and studying for the performance for the Little Mermaid. And best of all, you're invited to share in the performance. 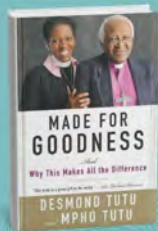

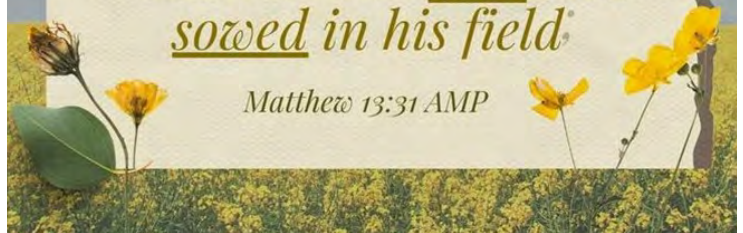
