When a Biscuit Is More than a Biscuit

This week the church office received a phone call and email message from a young lady whose very path in life was influenced by Wesley's cheese biscuits.

"I grew up in Windmill Plantation, fifteen minutes from your church. My family did not attend Wesley, or really any church for that matter, but I had a friend who did. Whenever she asked me to spend the night on a Saturday night, I would always be excited for church the next morning...your church. I'll be honest, I do not remember anything about the worship but I do remember the hospitality and the women who made and served those biscuits on Sunday mornings. They made me feel loved, and they didn't even know me.

That experience kept my warm feelings towards "the church" alive for a long time and later, when my husband and I married, we made being part of church a priority. We were not Methodist yet, but got married at Wesley Monumental in Savannah.

Years later, we moved to Charlotte and lived near Myers Park UMC and started attending. This was the first UMC church we actually became involved in. After a few years, I began working there and received my call to ministry. I went to seminary at Duke and this past Friday, I was ordained a deacon in the Indiana Annual Conference.

In full transparency, I did not even realize that the cheddar biscuits and gracious women were Methodist until a lightbulb went off this morning as I prepared my sermon for Sunday. On a whim, I looked up the closest Methodist church to where I grew up and gave you all a call.

I just wanted to let you (and hopefully your hospitality team!) know what a difference you all make - planting seeds that may take 25 years to grow, but they matter. I am grateful for you and all the ministry that you do."
