It's Summertime!

Usually when you hear those words, it implies a more leisurely pace, a more relaxed expectation - about everything. Not at Wesley it doesn't! We are in the midst of Vacation Bible School, where almost 500 children and volunteers have coalesced to create one of our most memorable VBS weeks in our church's history. It began weeks ago when adult volunteers built the most creative sets I've seen - a waterfall, tree house and vines hanging everywhere with accompanying sounds of the forest at every venue. It was great. Even more impressive is to see each morning so well run. We'll be showing a brief video this Sunday to let you see all that occurred this week.

And that's not all. A week from Friday, 43 members (31 students and 12 adults) of our congregation will be traveling to Guatemala for a week of mission and ministry. In that time, they will visit four different villages and in each setting they will pour concrete floors (in a country where dirt is customary ground cover). Our medical team will provide and offer care, and students will run a Vacation Bible School experience. Another team of nine adults will also depart next Friday to serve in Guatemala. It will be an incredible experience and will touch the lives of both those that serve and are served. Be in prayer for this experience.

After these two weeks, we will be offering five different summer camps and an additional mission trip for our middle school students to North Carolina. What a great summer - thank you for your support.

It is summertime, however, and we have jettisoned the robes as we acknowledge this time of the year. I encourage you to worship with us - we will be offering communion this Sunday as well.

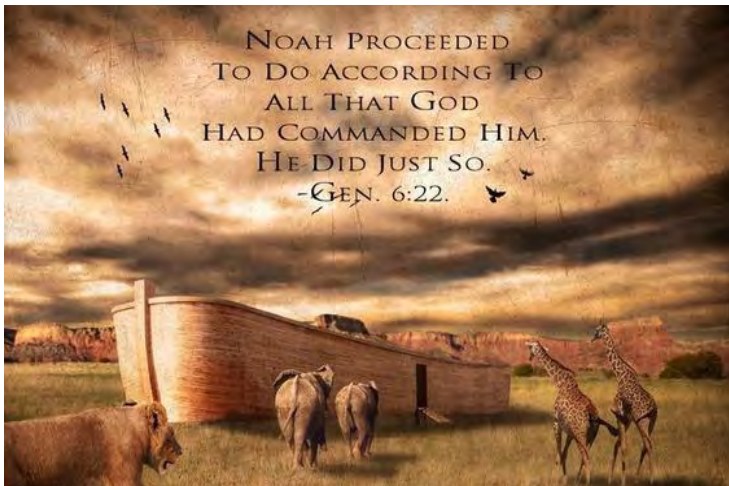

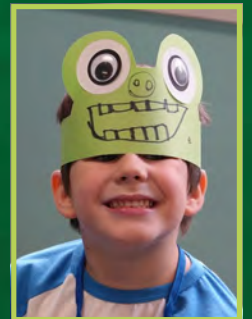
