

# FAMILY CONNECTION

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

## SCRIPTURE | Luke 4:1-14

### SESSION SUMMARY

---

Jesus came to earth to experience life as people do, even temptation, yet without sinning so that He could be the perfect sacrifice for our sin. Today's Scriptures show Jesus being led into the wilderness by the Holy Spirit to be tempted by Satan. He overcame temptation by leaning on God's Word. In this session, we see that God's Word is our powerful weapon against Satan's lies and against temptation. Here are the main themes:

- God's Word is our weapon (Luke 4:1-4).
- Satan flees when we cling to truth (Luke 4:5-14).

### CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

---

- Why is it important for our family to understand that God never tempts us but allows us to face temptations and trials to strengthen our faith?
- What temptations and trials are our family facing right now? How do Jesus's responses show us the way to respond in these situations?
- What are our family's two main defenses against the enemy?

### FAMILY CHALLENGE

---

We aren't perfect, and we will mess up—but sin isn't unavoidable. Scripture promises that God always provides a way for us to stand against temptation instead of choosing sin (1 Cor. 10:13). In this passage, we've seen one main way to fight temptation: God's Word. Brainstorm some helpful Scriptures to memorize to help you fight temptation, choosing one to memorize together this week. Try starting with something like: Proverbs 4:14-15; Hebrews 4:15; James 4:7; and 1 Peter 5:9.
