

FAMILY CONNECTION

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE | John 1:35-51

SESSION SUMMARY

Jesus invited people throughout His ministry to “Come and . . . see” (John 1:39) what He was doing. Almost immediately, we see His disciples turn and do the same, inviting those they knew to come and see what Jesus is all about. In this week's session, we'll see that following Jesus changes us and gives us new purpose. These are the key points:

- When we find Jesus, we tell others (John 1:35-46).
- Jesus sees us and knows us (John 1:47-51).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- On a scale of 1 to 10, how comfortable is our family, and each family member, with sharing our faith with others?
- Why do we sometimes hesitate to share our faith? What can we do to help each other overcome these hesitations to share our testimony and the gospel?
- When has our family felt like God didn't see us? How do Jesus's words in these verses comfort us?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Give each family member a journal or sheet of paper and invite them to prayerfully consider areas of life where they don't feel seen. Encourage them to journal about those areas. As you feel led and are comfortable, consider sharing and encouraging one another that God sees each of you—even here.
